WELCOME PASTOR ROB AND FAMILY!

At the specially called congregation meeting held Sunday, April 13th, the congregation overwhelmingly voted to issue a call to Pastor Rob Cosmas as the lead/senior pastor of St. Michael. Votes were 191 yes; 3 no (98.5% approval – far in excess of the 2/3rds required). Pastor Rob was informed of this via telephone conversation immediately after the congregation meeting and, as of April 15th, has verbally agreed to the call. The formal paperwork required to execute the call is in process.



Pastor Rob and family have a house to sell in Florida and will probably rent in Virginia Beach until they are able to purchase property. The target date to have Pastor Rob on board is early July. More details on timing and how you can help them settle in Virginia Beach will be provided in the days ahead.

WHAT IS A TRUSTEE?

At the April 13th meeting, Ken Allen, Jon Tamayo and Roger Whittaker were each re-elected to a six (6) year term as a trustee of St. Michael. All three have served in this position for many years and we thank them for their willingness to continue to serve in this capacity.



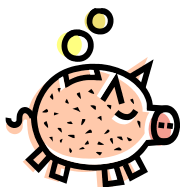
The function of trustee at St. Michael is a legal one; required by the Commonwealth of Virginia. The Commonwealth requires three actual persons to be legally recorded with the City of Virginia Beach as those persons who can sign mortgage papers or other legal documents. In the congregation, power exists with the congregation members who make the decisions regarding mortgages, sale or purchase of property, etc. but the trustees are those persons whose signatures appear on those documents as representatives of the congregation. This function is unique to Virginia and a requirement of the St. Michael constitution.

WANT TO SIMPLIFY YOUR LIFE?

Then sign up for “**Simply Giving**” a secure, electronic way of making your financial gifts to St. Michael. All you need do is fill out a short form, attached a voided check, submit both to the church office and, presto, you can forget about offering envelopes, writing checks or carrying cash or missing an offering when you are out of town. Forms are on the welcome center in the entrance area or thru the church office.

The best part about “**Simply Giving**” is its flexibility. You chose the frequency of your contributions – weekly, monthly, twice a month – whatever best suits your needs. How simple is that!!

And using “**Simply Giving**” saves the church money in bank fees and deposits – it’s a real winner for everyone!
